What Are We Learning?

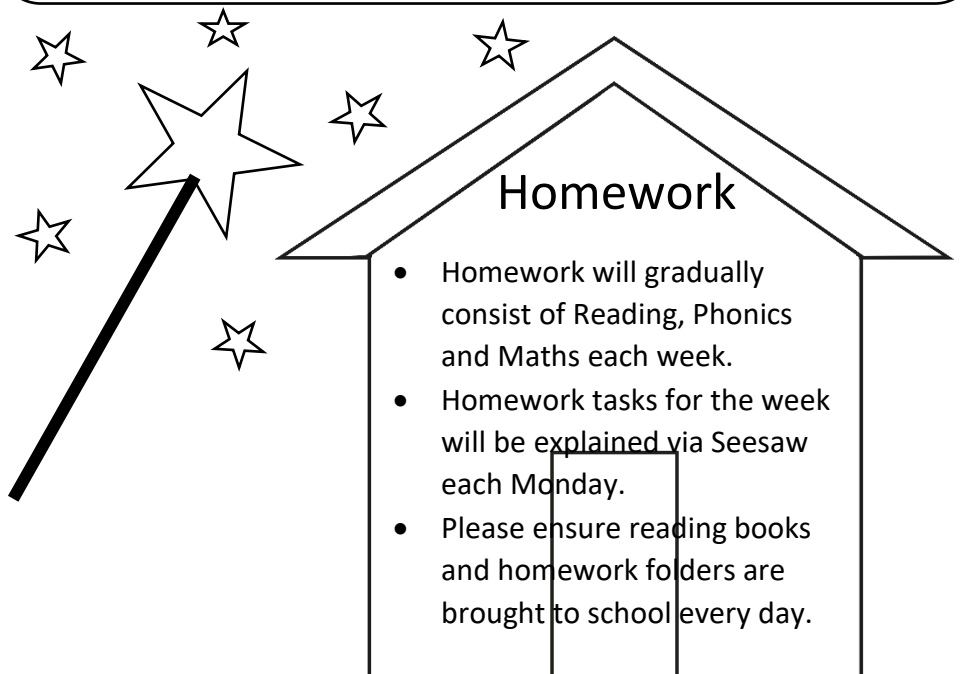
Reading: The children will be using Oxford Reading Tree books to develop their reading skills. Reading books will be sent home for your child to read each week, along with Stage Words to learn.

Phonics: With the help of the Phonic Fairy and the Tricky Troll, the children will be learning sounds using Story Time Phonics. Sounds will be sent home for children to learn and build words with.

Maths: Numicon will feature largely in our Maths lessons, as well as active learning and developing our arithmetic skills using counters, ten frames and domino patterns.
