What Are We Learning?


Reading: The children will be using the accelerated reading scheme where they will read a book of their choice and then take a short quiz.

Spelling: The children will be following the schools spelling scheme. They will be given a new spelling rule each week and spelling words that follow the rule. They will also be completing their common words.

Maths: Numicon will feature largely in our Maths lessons, as well as active learning. The children will be focussing on addition, subtraction, times tables and division in the first term.
