What Are We Learning?

Maths: In maths this term, we are having a focus on times tables which can be practised in school and at home! We are also looking at time, rounding and the four rules of number (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).

Writing: Look out for some magical pieces of writing linked to the Magic Castle. Children will be creating some pieces of writing which show their imaginative writing talents and creating a spooky spell to bewitch their friends or enemies!

Science – Primary six are looking at water this term and have been learning about the water cycle.
