Welcome to P4/3

What Are We Learning?

Reading: The children will be using real books and following their targets from the Accelerated Reading programme. Some children will have books sent home to reinforce vocabulary and comprehension skills.

Phonics and Spelling: Children will be given targeted spelling or phonics patterns to learn. Some children will also be working from the Common Word Lists to improve sight reading and spelling

Maths: Maths this term is developing understanding of place value and adding and subtracting skills. These skills will be taught through lots of practical examples and subsequently moving onto more abstract ideas.

Class Topic

This Term, our learning is based around a theme of The Rainforest. Children will be investigating fact files, posters and learning about the climate of the Rainforest. Hopefully we will have lots of experiences with Art, Maths, Geography and of course Literacy.

Homework

- Homework will gradually consist of Reading, Spelling and Maths each week.
- Homework tasks for the week will be explained via Seesaw each Tuesday.
- Please ensure reading books and homework jotters are brought back to school by Friday.
