What we are learning

Literacy: We are using visuals to continue to develop our recognition of vocabulary and to share with adults how we are feeling. We are using Colourful Semantics to help us with our writing. Our spelling will be covered through phonics and Nelson Spelling. We are continuing to focus on our social skills and to develop our talking and listening skills. Our reading will be through Oxford Reading Tree and Accelerated Reading, where appropriate.

Health and Wellbeing: We are excited to be developing our understanding of our school values to help us to create our Class Charter. We are also learning about our rights and using this to help with our Charter too!

Maths: We are continuing to work on our recognition of Days of the Week/Months of the Year and Seasons through our daily classroom routines. We are looking forward to develop our knowledge and understanding of Number using visual supports.

Class Topic

This Term, our class is learning about STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) and coding. The children love technology and are enthusiastically engaging with their tasks.

Homework

Homework will consist of reading, a spelling/phonics task and a numeracy task. These are designed to be fun and enhance the children's learning.
