Welcome to P3!

Outdoor Learning

Please ensure that your child brings a coat to school every day as they will be participating in outdoor learning in all weathers.

Please find some pointers below to help your child:

- Please name all items of clothing – this will really help when trying to find any lost ties or jumpers, etc.
- Please ensure your child brings a water bottle with them each day.
- Particularly on sunny days, please put sun cream in your child's bag.

What Are We Learning?

Reading: The children will continue to use Oxford Reading Tree books to develop their reading skills. We will also begin to use Accelerated Reading where children can choose a book of their choice at the appropriate level and then complete a quiz to check their comprehension of the book. Reading books will be sent home for your child to read each week, along with Stage Words and common words.

Literacy: With the help of the Phonic Fairy and the Tricky Troll, the children will continue to learn sounds using Story Time Phonics. Sounds will continue to be sent home for children to learn and build words with.

Maths: In Term 1 we will be focussing on place value, addition and subtraction and consolidating our number bonds. We will be using Heinemann Active maths and the children will continue to learn and consolidate their learning through activities and games.

Class Topic

This Term, our class is learning about STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) and coding. The children will use technology to learn Coding.

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PE Days

Primary 3 will have P.E. on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Children are still required to come to school wearing their P.E. kit on those days. P.E. uniform is blue shorts/track suit trousers and a white t-shirt. Football strips are not allowed at school.

Please note that all jewellery has to be removed for P.E. If earrings can't be removed due to the healing process then they must be covered with tape. Please provide tape for your child's ears until they are fully healed.

Homework

- Homework will consist of Reading, Phonics, Stage/Common words and Maths each week.
- Homework tasks will be issued on a Monday.
- Please ensure reading books and homework folders are brought to school every day.
