### The Curriculum

#### IDL

In Term 1 our focus will be on Digital Learning. Working with the children we will be exploring and getting creative with a range of digital materials. Children will be creating programmes and developing games we can't wait to get stuck in.

#### Literacy

Reading: The children will be using Bug Club to develop their reading skills along with Accelerated Reading.

Writing: We will be using Improving Writing techniques and Talk For Writing to support writing this year across various writing styles.

Spelling and Handwriting: Children will be following Nelson programs.

#### Numeracy

In Numeracy in term we will be building our children's number knowledge through the use of Maths Mastery. We would encourage you to work with your children on their times tables at home to support us.

### Homework

- Homework will be issued on a Monday and should be returned on a Thursday.
- Homework tasks will consist of Spelling and Numeracy linked to what the children are learning each week in class.
- Homework should be completed in the child's red homework jotter neatly, and preferable in pencil.
- We encourage you to support your child with reading at home regularly as this will support with their literacy attainment.
- If your child is struggling with their homework please encourage them to ask us in class before Thursday.

### PE Days
